**for the DL4000 Video Transport Platform**

All three chassis offer the same dependability and ruggedness users have come to expect from an Artel product. With slots for up to four modules in just 1.75” of height, a single rack unit, and unlimited non-spaced stacking the DL4000 is one of the most space efficient platforms on the market.
